## V. New Business -

A. Review snow removal proposals

The Committee reviewed four quotes to provide snow removal services for the 2024-25 season and discussed aspects of each. Snow Systems stood out because it offered longer coverage time. The Committee preferred Snow Systems' Option A because of the lower price.

The Committee will recommend the Board approve Snow Systems' Option A.

B. Electric vehicle chargers

Director Todd updated the Committee on the Library's plan to install electric vehicle chargers (EVCs). The Library already has wiring run to the location. Installing the chargers will require engineering because of safety issues. The charger and software can be combined – akin to iPhones and the iOS, or can be separate like Android with Samsung or Google phones. The Committee discussed pricing options and wish to be able to recoup installation costs and any ongoing maintenance and software fees incurred.

**VI. Other** – Director Todd updated the Committee on a conversation he had with Trane about potential work on the new boilers. Trane will gather more information so they can explain why work is needed so soon after the boilers were installed.
